On March 11, 2010, Mr. Alfredo Moreno was sworn in as Minister of Foreign Affairs of Chile. Minister Moreno graduated from San Ignacio El Bosque High School where he received the Best Student Award. He holds an Industrial Civil Engineering degree with the highest distinction from the Catholic University of Chile, and an MBA from the University of Chicago. Mr. Moreno has served as member of the Board in several companies. He also served as Chairman of the Instituto Chileno de Administración Racional de Empresas (ICARE), a prominent association that promotes excellence within the business community. Minister Moreno has a long-standing professional experience both in Chile and abroad. He is a member of G-50, a group of fifty Latin American leaders selected by Foreign Policy, one of the world's leading publications on international relations in the United States. He is also member of the Global Advisory Board at the University of the Chicago Booth School of Business (formerly known as "The University of Chicago Graduate School of Business"). In the said capacities, Mr. Moreno has cultivated an extensive network of international contacts both in the public and private sectors. In addition, he has held important positions in several non-profit organizations such as the Teletón Chile Foundation as well as the International Organization of the same name, which counts with 13 Latin American countries among its members. He is also a Board member of the Paz Ciudadana Foundation, which fosters active policies towards the reduction of crime. Foreign Minister Moreno, 54, was born in Santiago. He is married, and has four children.
