Darys Estrella Mordán became the CEO of the Dominican Republic's Stock exchange (BVRD) in April 2007. She went to the BVRD after working five years in the Fixed Income and the Human Capital Management divisions of Goldman Sachs & Co., where she was a Vice President. Before joining Goldman, Ms. Estrella spent seven years at the hedge fund Deltec Asset Management as a Vice President in the Emerging Markets Fixed Income Division covering Latin America. Ms. Estrella was selected as Young Global Leader in March 2008 by the World Economic Forum. In September 2008, she received The Presidential Medal from the City University of New York, the highest honor awarded by that institution. She is Secretary of La Asociación de Bolsas de Centroamérica y el Caribe (BOLCEN), and she is also a Member of the University of Michigan Stephen M. Ross Business School's Alumni Board of Governors. Ms. Estrella received her BA from Vassar College and her MBA from the University of Michigan. She completed the Executive Program at the Harvard John F. Kennedy School of Government on Leadership for the 21st Century.

New issues continue to emerge and the secondary market becomes more liquid every day. These trends represent continued confidence and maturing conditions in the local market.
