Mr. Enrique Iglesias is the current secretary at the Ibero-American General Secretariat. His former positions include: President of the Inter-American Development Bank, in Washington DC; Executive Secretary of the UN Economic Commission for Latin America and Caribbean, Santiago de Chile; Minister of Foreign Affairs, Government of Uruguay; Governor of the Central Bank of Uruguay; and Secretary of Planning, Uruguay. He has also been a University professor. Mr. Iglesias has received decorations from several countries: France (Legion d'Honneur), Spain (Isabel la Católica), Japan, Italy, Brazil, Argentina, Chile, Mexico, etc.

He is the former founder of Pro-Opera, Uruguay and he is Counsellor of the Royal Opera Theatre, Madrid, Spain.
