Dr Seek Ngee Huat is an Advisor to the Government of Singapore Investment Corporation (GIC) Group Executive Committee and is Chairman of its Latin America Business Group. Prior to joining GIC, Dr Seek was a senior partner with Jones Lang Lasalle (formerly Jones Lang Wootton), based in Sydney.

Dr Seek holds a Master of Science (Business Administration) from the University of British Columbia and a PhD in Urban Research from the Australian National University.
