From 1998 to 2000 he was the International chairman of CEAL - Conselho de Empresários da América Latina (Latin America Business Council) and for 8 years was the Chairman of the Brazilian chapter. He is the founder and Trustee Board member of CEBRI (Brazilian Center of International Relations). Member of the Advisory Board of BUNGE, Cia. Brasileira de Distribuição (Pão de Açúcar), Havas Brasil and BLADEX – Banco Latinoamericano de Exportaciones. Former Trustee of IASB – International Accounting Standards Board till December 2007. Partner of Prospectiva Consultoria Brasileira de Assuntos Internacionais. He is Board Member of BNDESPAR and President of the Arbitrage Chamber of the São Paulo Stock Market. Roberto is also member of GACINT - Grupo de Análise da Conjuntura Internacional (São Paulo University).
