



## Angela Gutierrez

Member of the Board of Trustees

Angela Gutierrez founded the Flávio Gutierrez Cultural Institute, responsible for the implementation and management of the Oratory Museum in Ouro Preto, the Sant'Ana Museum in Tiradentes, and the Museum of Arts and Crafts in Belo Horizonte. The collections of the three museums, gathered by the collector over decades of searches and research, were donated to the federal public heritage (IPHAN). Angela holds a degree in Business Administration from Fundação Getúlio Vargas, with a specialization in Marketing, and is a researcher of Brazilian Baroque, specializing in Sacred Art.

She has been a member of the Board of Trustees of Fundação Dom Cabral since 2000. She is part of the Board of Directors of the Andrade Gutierrez Group, as well as participating in the Advisory Board of the Brazilian Institute of Museums (IBRAM); the Board of Directors of the Cultural Foundation of the Archdiocese of Belo Horizonte; the Deliberative Council of the Friends of the Inconfidência Museum Association; the Advisory Board of the Rio Art Museum – MAR and the Advisory Board of the Rouanet Institute. She is a member of the Historical and Geographical Institute of Minas Gerais and provides national and international consultancy in the field of Museology and Artistic and Cultural Historical Heritage.

She was Secretary of Culture of the State of Minas Gerais, was part of the Advisory Board of the National Historical and Artistic Heritage Institute (IPHAN) from 06/15/1999 to 05/04/2022, and of the Board of the Minas Gerais Philharmonic Orchestra. Among the honors she received in the field of culture are: the National Museum Center of Art Reina Sophia, in Spain; the National Order of Cultural Merit; the Inconfidência Medal; the tribute, in 2010, from the Brazil Foundation, at the Metropolitan Museum, in New York – USA; the commendation of L'Ordre des Arts et des Lettres, merit recognized by the French government in 2011; the tribute by the Federation of the Academy of Letters and Culture of Minas Gerais, in addition to having been awarded in 2013 with the Reitor Mendes Pimentel Medal, the highest honor that the Federal University of Minas Gerais grants to professionals widely recognized in their specific areas.
