He has won international awards such as The International Architecture Award, the World Architecture Festival (WAF), the Architizer A+Awards, the Prix Versailles, the Building of The Year 2023, and twice the IF Design Awards.

Author of projects such as the Monument to Freedom of the Press in Brasília, the Japanese Immigration Memorial in Belo Horizonte, the Congonhas Museums (world cultural heritage), Sant'Ana and Regina Mundi in Congonhas, Tiradentes, and Caeté respectively, the new Mineirão Stadium, the Guignard School (considered one of the 30 most relevant works of architecture in Brazil), both in Belo Horizonte, the SesiLab, architectural requalification of the Touring Club building, designed by Oscar Niemeyer, in Brasília, the Brumadinho Memorial, in honor of the victims of the dam I rupture in Brumadinho, among others.

With 06 books published, his projects have been exhibited on the main architecture and design websites, magazines, and books in the world; such as ArchDaily, Abitare, Architecture Magazine, Architecture Now, Le Mounter Architecture Mars, Architectural Digest, Enlace, Monocle, Architectural Record, Wallpaper, SUMMA +, Tashen, among others.
