Oby is an economic policy expert and senior economic advisor at the Africa Economic Development Policy Initiative (AEDPI) in Abuja, providing support for government policies and advisory support to several country presidents and their cabinets.

In Nigeria, she served as Minister of Minerals and later as Minister of Education. She served as Vice President of the World Bank based in Washington-DC, responsible for the Africa Region program, leading projects, programs, research, and economic and sectoral studies in 48 sub-Saharan countries.

She is also a co-founder of Transparency International and was one of the pioneering directors of the institution's global board based in Berlin. In 2012, she became a senior economic advisor at the Open Society Foundation in New York, aiming to build vibrant and tolerant societies with democratically accountable governments.

She was nominated for the Nobel Peace Prize in 2018 and recognized as one of the 100 most influential people by Time magazine and one of the 25 women of impact by the New York Times, among other awards and recognitions.
