Retired professor at the Federal University of Minas Gerais, where he was director of the Center for Development and Regional Planning (CEDEPLAR) (1987-1988) and coordinator of the Postgraduate course in economics (1982-1983). He was Tinker Visiting Professor at Lyndon B. Johnson School of Public Affairs at The University of Texas at Austin, in the United States (2005).

In the government of Minas Gerais, he was President of the Banco de Desenvolvimento de Minas Gerais (BDMG) Secretary for Transport and Public Works. In the Federal government he was Minister of Planning and Budget (1988-1999) and Minister of Labor (1995-1998), President of the National Privatization Council and member of the National Monetary Council.

Professor Paulo was Vice President of Planning and Administration at the Inter-American Development Bank (IDB) (1999-2004) and Vice President of the Board of Directors of Instituto Inhotim (2011-2015).

He is an affiliate professor at Fundação Dom Cabral (FDC) and Member of the Economic Policy Council of the Federation of Industries of Minas Gerais (FIEMG). He has published books and articles on economic growth and population growth, the labor market and public policies.
