



## Angela Gutierrez

Member of the Board of Trustees

Angela Gutierrez holds a degree in Business Administration from Fundação Getúlio Vargas and a Specialist degree in Marketing. She is a researcher of the Brazilian Baroque and a collector of sacred art. In 1998, she founded the Flávio Gutierrez Cultural Institute (ICFG), being responsible for the creation and implementation of the Oratory Museum, in Ouro Preto (MG); the Sant'Ana Museum, in Tiradentes (MG); and the Museum of Arts and Crafts, in Belo Horizonte (MG). The collections of the three institutions, gathered by the collector over decades of searches and research, were donated to the Patrimony of the Union.

Currently, Angela Gutierrez chairs the ICFG and is a member of the Instituto Histórico e Geográfico de Minas Gerais, in addition to carrying out national and international consultancies in the area of Museology and Historical Artistic and Cultural Heritage. She was Secretary of Culture of the State of Minas Gerais and has been a member of the Board of Trustees at Fundação Dom Cabral since the year 2000.

She was in charge of the editorial coordination of books and other publications on Brazilian Art and Cultural Heritage, such as: "Ouro Preto, Tempo sobre Tempo"; "Alcântara, Cantos do Silêncio"; "O Burro e o Boi no Presépio", by João Guimarães Rosa; "Francisco Vieira Servas - e o Barroco Brasileiro"; "ABC do Museu"; "O Brasil na Fonte - Campo das Vertentes"; "Oratórios Brasileiros – Objetos da Fé"; "O livro de Sant'Ana", "MAO – Museu de Artes e Ofícios", in addition to all publications by Instituto Cultural Flávio Gutierrez.
