Guilherme Emrich has been a business leader for over 30 years. He graduated in Engineer, is an alumnus emeritus at UFMG and has attended many post-graduation programs in Business Management in the US and Europe.

He was the founder, CEO and later Chairman of the Board of Biobrás S.A., a company that grew from the start-up stage to become the fourth largest insulin producer in the world in his incumbency.

He is also an investor and Chairman of the Boards of several biotechnology and information technology in Brazil and in the United States.

Guilherme Emrich sits in several Boards, among which the Board of Trustees of Fundação Dom Cabral, a school that has strategic alliances with the Kellogg School (US), INSEAD (France) and UBS – University of British Columbia (Canada); the International Council of INSEAD – The European Institute of Business Administration and the Scientific Advisory Committee on International Cooperation, created in the Ministry of Science and Technology.

In addition, Mr. Emrich is a founding partner of Fir Capital Partners – Gestão de Investimentos S.A., a manager of venture capital funds for technologically-based companies, and Chairman of the Board of Trustees of Fundação Biominas, the largest biotechnology cluster in Latin America.
