

Cândido Fernandes Substitute Member of the Fiscal Council

Cândido Fernandes is an economist and university professor. Born in Lavras, MG, Dr. Fernandes is a bachelor of Economics from UFMG, a bachelor of Law from PUC-MG, a Master of Economics from CEDEPLAR-UFMG and a Doctor of Economics from UFRJ's Institute of Economics.

Dr. Fernandes worked as an economist for Fundação João Pinheiro, Aço Minas Gerais S.A (AÇOMINAS), the State Office for Planning and Coordination of Minas Gerais and Development Bank of Minas Gerais.

He is a retired professor from the UFMG's Department of Economics, former director of the Statistics and Information Center of Fundação João Pinheiro (1993-1994), former deputy director of UFMG School of Economics (1997-2001) and former chairman of the Regional Council of Economics of Minas Gerais (2011).

Dr. Fernandes has been a professor at UNIFENAS since 2001, besides working as a consultant in the area of economics, having provided services as a partner of PSM Consultores Associados Ltda. Dr. Fernandes has published many papers on economics in magazines, books and congress proceedings.

He is currently president of the research institute IPEAD-MG - Fundação Instituto de Pesquisas Econômicas, Administrativas e Contábeis de Minas Gerais and a guest professor of several lato and stricto sensu graduate programs (Fundação Dom Cabral, CEPEAD-UFMG, IEC- PUC, etc.), in addition to sitting in FDC's Audit Committee.

Dr. Fernandes has been granted the following awards: Outstanding Economic Award, granted by the CORECON-MG and the V Minas Gerais Economic Development Award - Darcy Ribeiro Medal (Outstanding Educator in Minas Gerais), granted in 2011 by ASSEMG and the Common Market.
