Was president of SUCESU, ASSESPRO, director of FUMSOFT member of the Minas Gerais Computer Science Council and of the CETEC Board of Trustees. Was president of the CIEE-MG (Company-School Integration Center of Minas Gerais), of which he is honorary chairman. He is a founding partner of Instituto Horizontes of AAMHAB (Association of Friends of the Abílio Barreto History Museum), of AMICAD (Association of Friends of the Minas Gerais Academy of Literature) and vice-president of the Minas Gerais Trade Association. He belongs to the FIEMG Policy and International Markets Council and is a Councilman at the Alliance Française.
