She joined the Energisa group 14 years ago to take over the firm's energy trading operations and in 2006 led the start-up of Energisa Comercializadora.

Alessandra is a member of the FIRJAN Electric Energy Business Council, Chair of the Energy Committee of AMCHAM (American Chamber of Commerce of Rio de Janeiro) and Representative of Energisa at ABRACEEL (Brazilian Energy Traders Association) and COGEN (Association for the Promotion of Cogeneration)

Previously, she worked at Light, Coca-Cola and Vale, occupying several management functions in the areas of Planning and Operations.

Alessandra holds an MBA from Fundação Dom Cabral (1993); a degree in Economics from the Federal University of Rio de Janeiro (1992) - Magna Cum Laude; a Master's Degree in Production Engineering (in the Finance and Investment Analysis area) from PUC / RJ (1997); and an MBA (in Marketing) from COPPEAD / UFRJ (2001).

In 1992, she placed 1st in the ANPEC Economics Competition; was awarded the Visconde de Cayru Prize in Economics by the Federal University of Rio de Janeiro; and, won the 4th Annual Corecon/RJ best thesis award for her work entitled "Oliver Williamson's Theory of Transaction Costs - A Theory Analysis". In 1993, she also received the Unibanco Award for Academic Performance.

Her Master's dissertation ("Fundraising in the Bonds Market - an analysis of CVRD's 2004-fixed rate notes") at PUC-RJ (in Production Engineering) was approved with distinction. She has published several other articles in periodicals focused on economics and energy.
