He is a member of the Economic and Social Council of the Universidad Di Tella; of the International Advisory Council of the Fundação Dom Cabral (FDC - Brasil); of the Directorio de Endeavor (Argentina); and of the Board of the Centro de Implementación de Políticas Públicas para la Equidad y el Crecimiento (CIPPEC). He is Member of the Inter American Dialogue (IAD); Consejo de la Productividad y Competitividad de Iberoamérica; Consejo Asesor de la Asociación de Emprendedores de Argentina (ASEA); Consejo Asesor de Entrepreneurship and Competitiveness Latin American Program (ECLA) of the Columbia University. In addition, he is Secretary and Founder of the Argentine Chamber of Biotechnology (CAB) and, for 8 years, he was a Member of the Board of Directors of AAPRESID. And since November 2021, he was appointed as a Board Member of the Consejo Argentino para las Relaciones Internacionales (CARI).

During the last 10 years he was chosen as one of the 5 most prestigious entrepreneurs in Argentina. In addition, he received some distinctions and recognitions:

He received the Order of Rio Branco awarded by the government of Brazil.

As a musician and singer he participated in his youth in several choirs and studied singing with the teacher Lucía Maranca. Together with the Cruz del Sur Trio he released 3 CDs dedicated to Argentine folk music. In addition, he develops an intense activity as a soloist exhibiting a repertoire dedicated to Argentine chamber music accompanied by Lucía Maranca and, currently, by the pianists Carlos Morán and Carlos Koffman; and to Argentine folk music accompanied by pianists Gustavo Hernandez and Matías Martino and maestro José Félix Boses.

Throughout his career, he gave numerous concerts, including at the Teatro San Martín, the Kirchner Cultural Center, the Usina del Arte, the Teatro 25 de Mayo, the Centro Cultural Borges, the Teatro Avenida, the Teatro Alvear, the Teatro de El Círculo, and in several Argentine towns and provinces, as well as in Paris and London.
